Students contact the program secretary and request to apply for a student visa by:

- 1) Prepare supporting documents as follow: (All files in PDF)
 - 1. Copy of Passport
 - 2. ID photo in a file
 - 3. Inform address of your residence in Chiang Mai
 - 4. Inform **city** in your country that the Royal Thai Embassy / Royal Thai Consulate-General is located
- *Noted Royal Thai Embassy/Consulate-General may require more documents depending on rules of each countries.
- 2) <u>Wait for the documents package from the program secretary which includes:</u> (All in hard copies)
- · Chiang Mai University documents
 - 1. A cover Letter from university
 - 2. A cooperation letter from Chiang Mai University
 - 3. An acceptance letter from Chiang Mai University
 - 4. A copy of a authorized person's ID card
- · Student's personal documents
 - 5. Passport and A copy of passport
 - 6. A copy of tuition fee receipt
- **3) Submit documents** to Royal Thai Embassy / Royal Thai Consulate-General at your country.
- 4) Use approved visa to enter the Kingdom of Thailand
- **5) Send a copy of visa expiration date page** to the <u>program secretary.</u>

*Cautions for International Students

- Student must notify your residence in Chiang Mai at the immigration office (near Chiang Mai Airport/at the 2nd floor, Central Festival Chiang Mai) within 24 hours since arriving Chiang Mai (for more information please visit: https://cmu.to/GMMIX) and (download TM.30 form at https://cmu.to/Vuzwu).
- 2. Student must **report at Chiang Mai Immigration Office every 90 days** (15 days before deadline).
- 3. Once receiving the visa, students who temporarily leave the Kingdom of Thailand have to do a **re-entry** application before leaving the Kingdom of Thailand. **If not, the visa will be automatically terminated** and students must apply for a new visa before entering the Kingdom of Thailand.
- 4. It is **illegal** for Non-immigrant Education visa to work in the Kingdom of Thailand.
