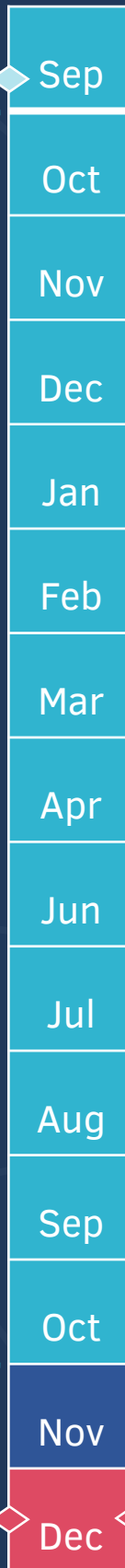

90 Days Report

Student must report at
Chiang Mai Immigration Office
every 90 days
(15 days before deadline).

Continually stay as
Chiang Mai University Business School student
in Thailand and **have to extend the visa for every year**
(30 days before the visa expiration date)
until graduation or termination of student status

Cancelling
For Visa

Student contact the program secretary and request
to cancel for a student visa by:

1) Prepare supporting documents as follow: (All files in PDF)

1. A copy of passport (First page)
2. A copy of type of visa page
3. A copy of visa expiration date page

2) Wait for the documents package from the program
secretary which includes: (All in hard copies)

- University documents
 1. Termination Letter from university
- Student's personal documents
 2. Passport and A copy of passport

3) Submit documents to Chiang Mai Immigration Office

***Cautions for International Students**

1. Students who temporarily leave the Kingdom of Thailand have to do a **re-entry** application before leaving the Kingdom of Thailand. If not, **the visa will be automatically terminated** and students must apply for a new visa before entering the Kingdom of Thailand.
2. **Students who are in the case showing here: Resign/Terminate/Transfer to other institute/Graduate must contact the program secretary to request for cancelling the visa within 2 weeks** and no later than 1 month after the approved date. Otherwise, there is a fine (500 Baht/day, but not exceeding 20,000 Baht) and students will be prohibited to entry the Kingdom of Thailand (depending on the overstay period).
3. When the cancellation is completed, a permission to stay in Thailand will end immediately. The student must leave Thailand within 24 hours.
