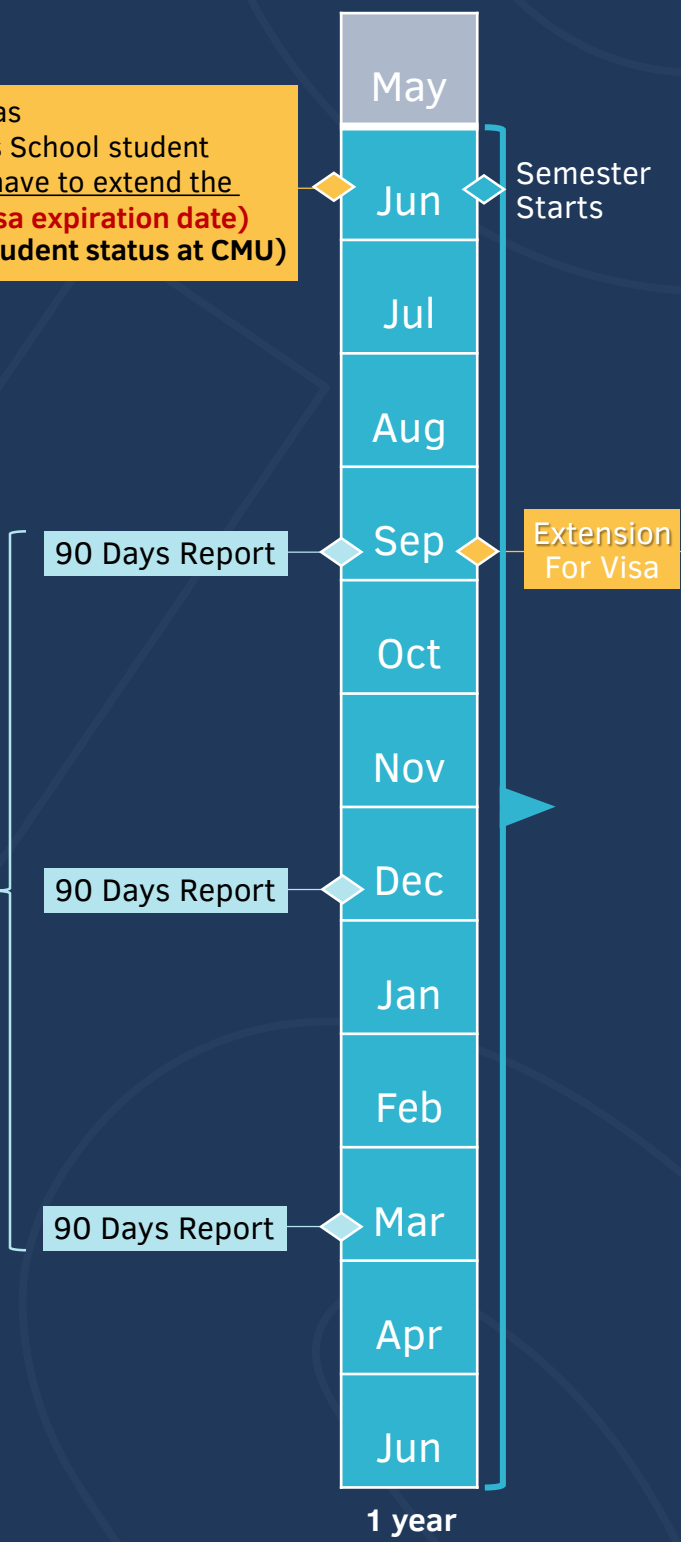

“For International Students”

Continually stay as Chiang Mai University Business School student in the Kingdom of Thailand and have to extend the visa every year (30 days before visa expiration date) until graduation or termination of student status at CMU

Student must report at Chiang Mai Immigration Office every 90 days (15 days before deadline).



Students contact the program secretary and request to extend for a student visa by:

- 1) Prepare supporting documents as follow: (All files in PDF)**
 1. A copy of passport (First page)
 2. A copy of type of visa page
 3. A copy of visa expiration date page
 4. ID photo in a file
 5. A copy of the latest transcript from CMU registration office or website
- 2) Wait for the documents package from the program secretary which includes: (All in hard copies)**
 - **Chiang Mai University documents**
 1. A cover Letter from Chiang Mai University
 2. A cooperation letter from Chiang Mai University
 3. Name of foreigners in the Chiang Mai University
 4. Application for extension of temporary stay in the Kingdom of Thailand (download TM.7 form at <https://cmu.to/4Hz52>)
 - **Student's personal documents**
 5. Passport and A copy of passport
 6. A copy of latest transcript at CMU
- 3) Submit documents to Chiang Mai Immigration Office**
 - 3.1 Immigration Office (near Chiang Mai Airport)**

 - 3.2 Immigration Office (at the 2nd floor, Central Festival Chiang Mai)**
Opens Mon-Fri at 9.00 am – 5.00 pm

- 4) Report at the Immigration within 90 days (15 days before deadline) and extend the visa for another 9 months (in the first year) to stay in the Kingdom of Thailand. After that, students must extend the visa every year (30 days before visa expiration date) until graduation or termination of student status.**
- 5) Send a copy of visa expiration date page to the program secretary.**

*Cautions for International Students

1. Student must **report at Chiang Mai Immigration Office every 90 days** (15 days before deadline).
2. Students who temporarily leave the Kingdom of Thailand have to do a **re-entry** application before leaving the Kingdom of Thailand. If not, **the visa will be automatically terminated** and students must apply for a new visa before entering the Kingdom of Thailand.
3. Non-immigrant Education visa is **not allowed to work** in the Kingdom of Thailand.
